- Field Safety, Pratt Carter and Ed Popp reported no major problems at the field.
- Mowing, Carl Angleberger has made up a revised mowing schedule and mowing protocol. Mowing team members please read the new protocol. Copies are posted in the mower shed and on the bulletin board. Carl's new protocol is designed to protect the mowers from unnecessary wear and tear and damage. - Two additional locks for the sheds were purchased as spares. They are keyed the same as the originals.
- Old Business:
 - The North South runway improvements have been on hold due to the wet conditions. The membership voted to spend up to \$400 to have a contractor move the dirt filling the holes and washouts and then leveling the area. Once that has been done, grass will be planted. Pratt Carter is heading up this effort.
 - Primary Runway, The East West runway reconstruction was completed on May1st. Thanks to Mickey's crew, for a job well done. Both halves of the mat were rolled back from the center and gravel and dirt was used to fill the wash outs and holes. That was compacted and then visqueen was laid down prior to the mat being put back and stapled in place. Work started around 8 AM and was finished by noon. Thanks again to all who helped.
- New Business:
 - Vents will be installed in the two storage containers to prevent a buildup of gas fumes.
 - Ron Tibbetts announced that the AMA has awarded our SES Club a grant of \$400 for runway improvements. We thank Ron for his efforts in applying for this grant.
