Southern Eagles Squadron Meeting Minutes December 18, 2014 Leesburg Community Center

The meeting was called to order by President Mickey Murphy at 7:00 PM.

A quorum was met with 18 members present.

- Minutes of the last meeting were approved as presented.
- One guest was present, Evie Rudnitsky - wife of Treasurer Jerry Rudnitsky
- One new member was present, Kyle Spradlin
- The Treasurers report was given by Treasurer Jerry Rudnitsky. Jerry reported a net profit of \$891 from the November Swap Meet.
- Membership - Ralph Savino reported SES has 159 paid members year to date for 2014.
- Field Safety - Ed Popp & Pratt Carter asked flyers to loudly call out landings and takeoffs. Pratt also suggested the flight stations on the East West runway be moved closer together.
- Field Report - Mickey thanked all SES members who helped with the work on the North South runway move. All of the old flight stations and the white building were moved. The equipment and building from the old North South pit area is now completely cleared. The new North South pit area is operational.
 - Yet to be completed, the disposal of all left over flight station fencing and PVC, moving the cement building tie downs and voting on the proposed extension of the Geotech runway surface to intersect with the Geotech material that has been proposed for the North South runway.
- Mowing - Carl reported the mowers were pretty much trouble free except the ignition switch was left turned on on one of the big mowers and the battery is dead. A new battery will be installed by Tom Gagish. Tom has been a great asset to the Club by repairing the mowers very quickly. Thank you Tom. To show our appreciation, members voted to provide Tom free membership for 2015. The 2015 Mowing Schedule will be available January 1.
- Election of Club Officers - Norm Paddock volunteered to be the new Vice President. Since no other members came forward, the current President Mickey Murphy, Treasurer Jerry Rudnitsky, Secretary Wayne Roethler, and Membership chairman Ralph Savino agreed to stay in their positions for 2015.
- The gate code will be changed effective January 15, 2015. All members who have paid their 2015 dues will be notified of the new code. Members with Email will be contacted that way and the few members without email will be sent a letter.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:35 PM.
