Southern Eagles Squadron Meeting Minutes January 15, 2015 Leesburg Community Center

The meeting was called to order by President Mickey Murphy at 7:03 PM.

A quorum was met with 17 members present.

- Minutes of the last meeting were approved as presented.
- The Treasurers report was given by Treasurer Jerry Rudnitsky.
- Membership - Ralph Savino reported SES had 162 paid members for 2014 and has 127 so far in 2015. Ralph thanked Carl Dilks and Carl Angleberger for their efforts in talking to new flyers and making sure they know they must join the Club to use the field.
- Field Safety - Carl Dilks and Gary Jeffcoat were appointed as additional Field Safety Officers. Pilots are asked to loudly call out landings and takeoffs and yell out a warning if you or your plane is in trouble. This warning is important so other pilots can be alerted to possible danger. Two different crashes were discussed. One plane ended up near the dumpsters in the recycling area to the great dismay of the workers there.
- Field Report - Mickey & Carl Dilks have worked hard dismantling and separating the left over materials from the runway consolidation project. Some materials were saved, but the remainder must be disposed of.
 - The consensus of the members present was to delay any action on installing Geotech runway material on the North South runway. A motion was approved to purchase more rye grass seed and plant it in the bare spots on and near the North South runway areas.
- Mowing - Carl reported the mowers are all in good shape after some recent minor repairs by Tom Gagish. The 2015 Mowing Schedule is available and is posted on the SES website. www.southerneaglesquadron.com/ Don't drive movers over the gravel/stone areas with the blades running. Carl asked that when starting the big mowers, open the throttle to maximum, then pull open the choke and then turn the key to start. Thank you to Carl for his fine efforts in field maintenance and the new runway consolidation.
- The gate code was changed effective January 16, 2015. All members who have paid their 2015 dues were notified of the new code. Members with Email were contacted that way and the few members without email were sent a letter.
- New Business - A motion was approved to build 3 to 5 new double replacement tables for the pit area. Some old tables are in bad shape. A work party will be needed to complete them.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:04 PM.
